Some problems with legal assisted suicide:

- New paths of elder abuse (inheritance setting)
- Steerage to suicide by health care systems
- Trauma to patients and family members
- Sending wrong message to young people on life and problems
- Encouraging those with years to live, to throw away their lives
- Once legal, expansion of euthanasia to other vulnerable groups
