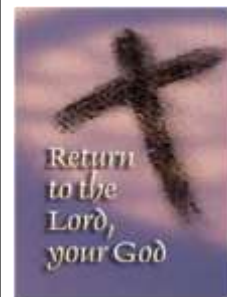

RETURNING TO GOD THIS LENTEN SEASON

Lent invites us to move forward; to move closer to God.

The 40-day Lenten season is our annual preparation for the Easter celebration. Lent is a time for conversion, self-denial and self-reflection but especially for **"returning to God with our whole heart"** (Joel 2:12).



During Lent we recommit ourselves to being

"practicing Catholics," to living by the laws of Christ and the church and to *disciplining* ourselves so we can be open to the grace to grow in faith, hope and love. We are provided with the means during Lent to *grow* through *prayer, reflection, repentance and giving to those in need*. We are invited and encouraged at every opportunity to turn back to God.

Following Ash Wednesday, we may find a good place to continue our Lenten journey is through our Friday *Stations of the Cross* at 5:00 pm and Friday Mass at 5:30 pm.

To aid us with repentance and healing, our *Communal Penance Services* on March 30th at 12:00pm and private confessions from 5:00-6:00pm will help us open our minds and hearts to God's forgiveness, words of healing, and promise of everlasting life.

Our Church also provides ways to help others through giving to our parish and the charitable organizations we support, and the Diocesan Annual Catholic Appeal, and special collections such as *Catholic Relief Services* on March 26 and by donating through the *CRS Rice Bowls campaign*. CRS Rice Bowls are a great way to involve the whole family in giving. What you give up for Lent changes lives!

We can also provide prayers, encouragement, and support for our *RCIA and RCIC Catechumens and Candidates* as they continue to seek full communion with the Catholic Church during Easter.

This Lent, may we hear God lovingly call us to repent, return to him, and be open to the unique blessings bestowed during this holy season. Let us thank God for what will be done for us in the days ahead.

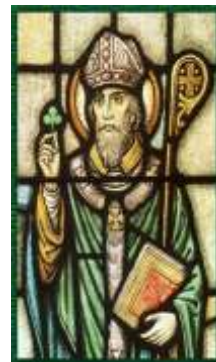
