Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:
Luke 24:13-35

Today we will hear the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, a story that we may find played out in our own lives more than we realize. Two despondent followers of Jesus walk away from Jerusalem, not knowing which way to turn. All their hopes have been dashed.

We too have walked that road when our life had been disrupted, our dreams snatched away. Then miraculously, like the disciples in the story, we discover **God's presence in the midst of our despair. Let us listen for God's message to us today in the holy words of the scripture.**

Question of the week: Where did I encounter Jesus, perhaps by surprise, this past week? Where will I look for Jesus in the week that lies ahead?

Alleluia, He is Risen!
Happy Easter!

We said this joyful greeting to each other on Easter Sunday, and yet for Catholics, Easter is so much more than a single celebration. Easter is so important that we cannot celebrate it in one day. To fully celebrate the Easter Season it takes fifty days, or a Pentecost (the Greek word for fifty). And each one of these fifty days, in fact, is Easter. That is why the Church speaks of the Sundays *of* Easter, rather than the Sundays *after* Easter. And what do we celebrate during this fifty-day Alleluia? Jesus' resurrection from the dead, His eternal and everlasting victory over death and the gift of salvation poured out upon the world! Let us continue to spread the "Happy Easter" Good News of Jesus' resurrection every day!

GIVE A GIFT OF HOPE

The tragic violence in the Middle East and the highly restrictive policies imposed by the government of Israel on Palestinians have created severe economic instability for Arab Palestinian Christians who live in the area of Bethlehem, a name which means "House of Bread."



In the neighboring village of Beit-Sahour, from where the shepherds most likely came to be the first people to worship the Christ Child, Palestinian Christian families have carved exquisite olive wood religious works for generations. Current travel restrictions imposed by Israel on Palestine have dramatically reduced both pilgrimages and tourism. The livelihood of these Christian families is severely threatened.

Mr. Victor Hannuneh is part of a group of Palestinian Christians traveling around our country selling these superb carvings. The revenue generated helps to restore justice to an oppressed Palestinian Christian minority, supports over 300 families of skilled carvers and helps in keeping a Christian presence in the Holy Land.

Victor will display the carvings after each Mass on the weekend of May 6-7. Your purchase, however small or big, will be an act of social justice as well as provide an opportunity to own or give as gifts original folk art from Bethlehem.
