Matthew 10:37-42 Jesus said to his apostles:
"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not
worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more
than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take
up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.
Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his
life for my sake will find it." "Whoever receives you
receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one
who sent me. Whoever receives a prophet because he is
a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and whoever
receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man
will receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever
gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones
to drink because the little one is a disciple—amen, I say
to you, he will surely not lose his reward."

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word: While Jesus
in today's Gospel does call us to sacrifice, his emphasis (and
that of the first reading) seems to be on the rewards that
disciples can expect. Discipleship is not without cost, but
**God's gratitude is boundless. Let us listen today for what
God is asking each of us to do, and let us pray for the
willingness to do it without counting the cost.**

Question of the week: In reflecting on sacrifices and
rewards of Christian discipleship, what sacrifice do you think
God is asking of you today? What reward do you think will
make it worthwhile?

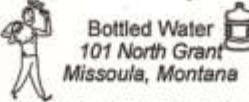
