[John 6:51-58](#) Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

[Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:](#) All of our readings today give us rich images to help us grasp the meaning of the Eucharist: manna, cup of blessing, one loaf, living bread. As we listen to the holy word of God today, **let's allow ourselves to rest in these and the other words and phrases that we will hear, and give them a chance to feed our soul so that we can come to the table truly ready to celebrate and receive the Body and Blood of Christ.**

### The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

**"God gave us the Eucharist as the most perfect act of thanksgiving."**

- *Hiking the Camino: 500 Miles with Jesus*

For many of us, June is the first month of "real summer." But it is also a month that

contains a feast day that helps us develop a deeper appreciation for the **"Real Presence"** of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. This year, on June 18, we celebrate the **Feast of Corpus Christi**, which is the Latin term for **"Body of Christ"**. The feast day dates back to the 13th century when a Bishop in Belgium instituted a special day to pay homage to the Eucharist. In 1264, Pope Urban IV made Corpus Christi a universal feast day in the Church. The date of the feast was set for the Thursday following Trinity Sunday. St. Thomas Aquinas wrote the official prayers for the feast day, and his words became the basis for the traditional hymns *"Tantum Ergo"* and *"Pange Lingua."* Traditionally the feast day was celebrated with a Eucharistic procession followed by Benediction. This tradition is still observed in some parishes. In 1983, the American Bishops moved the feast day from Thursday to the Sunday. We gather each Sunday at God's gracious invitation to be nourished in the Eucharist. In particular on the feast day of Corpus Christi, we call to mind this memorial handed down to us through the ages. In today's readings, we are reminded of Christ's Passover meal with the disciples as well as the covenant we have made with our Lord: Christ's very Body and Blood, given to us on Calvary and made present every time we do what he commanded us to do at this altar. To receive the Bread of Life is to make the commitment to become the Bread of Life. **May our prayer today be one of thanksgiving for this great gift of the Eucharist.**

Please remember that Last Rites are not the Anointing, but holy Communion, given as 'Viaticum' which means 'on the way with you'. **When giving communion as 'Viaticum' the priest or minister prays that the person be welcomed into eternal life. 'Viaticum' can only be given to those who are conscious and can be given frequently, even daily, when the person is dying.**
