Matthew 21-27 Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer greatly from the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed and on the third day be raised. Then Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke him, "God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you." He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life? Or what can one give in exchange for his life? For the Son of Man will come with his angels in his Father's glory, and then he will repay all according to his conduct."

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word: Jeremiah in today's first reading shows us what it means to truly belong to God. He cannot suppress the message that **God has planted within him. As we hear God's holy word today, listen for the message God has planted within you. How will it burn within your heart, and how will you express it in the world?**

Question of the week: **Jesus bids me 'deny myself' before 'taking up the cross' and 'following'.** What radical shift of values, reordering of priorities, refocusing of vision **must take place in my heart as discipleship's non-negotiable** Step Number 1?

TO THE NATIONS:

Stephen Smith OFS, President and Founder of TO THE NATIONS recently shared these incidents from his mission in Uganda: About two weeks prior to his mission, a 7-year old boy drowned when he slipped into a contaminated, unprotected water source from which he was fetching water for his family on the way to school. Three days later, To The Nations received enough funds to provide the village with a water line delivering clean water for the entire village. During the digging of the water line a little girl came to school with her lunch bucket which was usually empty, but this day it had in it three small pieces of a potato. She said it was to be her dinner the night before, but hid it in her bucket to give to the men who were digging the water line as they didn't have anything to eat and would need to eat something to be strong enough to continue the work. This was a huge sacrifice for her as she normally only receives 3-4 meals like this in a week! Stephen found out that it would cost \$2800 to provide a daily meal for all 299 children in the village and another \$1400 to construct a soup kitchen to prepare the meals. Within a week of returning home he was able to wire the funds needed to build and pay for the food for a full year for every child. Thanks be to God.
