

# February 11, 2018—The Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time



*Alleluia! Alleluia!*  
A great prophet has arisen in our midst,  
God has visited his people.  
*Alleluia! Alleluia!*

Mark 1:40-45 A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once. He said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed; that will be proof for them." The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly. He remained outside in deserted places, and people kept coming to him from everywhere.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word: Leprosy features prominently in the first reading and the Gospel today. In Leviticus, the leper is kept outside the community so as to protect everyone else from this communicable disease. But the leper in Mark challenges Jesus and Jesus breaks down the barrier between them, reaches out, touches him, and heals him. As we listen to **today's readings, consider how we exclude others in our lives, perhaps because we feel they would make us 'unclean', and how Jesus would respond.**

Question of the week: How can our compassion lead us to break barriers and bring healing to others, thereby giving glory to God?
