[John 3:14-21](#) Jesus said to Nicodemus: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God.

[Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:](#) The boundless love of God is on full display in the readings today. The Chosen People had 'added infidelity to infidelity', repeatedly turning away from God. But God still loved them, and through Cyrus, the king of Persia, the Exile was ended and Jerusalem restored. Paul testifies that our salvation comes because of God's great love for us. In the Gospel, we hear John attest that Jesus was sent to save the world because God 'so loved the world'.

[Question of the week:](#) What do I do in the darkness that needs to be brought into the light? Is it something that can stand the glare of truth or is it something that I need to stop doing?

Fundraising Update

At our last Finance Council Meeting, February 22, we discussed the essential need to take care of some deferred maintenance projects at the Parish Life Center. These projects are:

- repair bird damage on Northeast side of building
- replace second story thermal glass windows
- install outside lighting on Northeast side of building

Besides normal upkeep, the necessity for these projects is for our health, energy conservation, and safety; respectively.

The council also recommended that these deferred maintenance projects be bid, funded, and completed sooner rather than later. Most likely this coming Spring. The funding for all three maintenance projects would come from the surplus funds raised for the recent church roof replacement. (\$15,000.00)

Fundraising efforts for the parking lot replacement will continue by adding to the \$16,750.00 already raised specifically for the parking lot replacement until reaching the goal of \$50k . There was additional discussion of the possible need to temporarily patch parts of the parking lot for safety reasons until such a time that complete funding for the entire replacement of the parking lot is achieved.
