#### 1929-2023

Claude Anthony Huguet was born November 14, 1929, in Green Bay, WI. He married Donna Tubbs at St. Anthony's Parish on April 7, 1951 and together they raised 9 children.

Claude had great faith in his Catholic religion and served as a lector and usher for many years. Elected Grand Knight of Council 1021 of the Knights of Columbus, he remained a lifetime member. In 1962 he created Missoula Eyewear Center and in 1998, along with daughter Jennifer, he opened a high-end optical boutique, Specctica, in downtown Missoula. Claude worked there until retiring in 2010.
