## A special invitation is extended to all judges, lawyers, legislators, government officials and law school students.



Liturgically, the Red Mass gets it's name from the red color of vestments worn by the clergy symbolizing the tongues of fire and is celebrated as the Solemn Mass of the Holy Spirit.
