WHAT IS A RED MASS?

A Red Mass is traditionally celebrated each year at the Cathedral in October, marking the opening of the Supreme Court's annual term. It's purpose is to invoke God's blessings on those responsible for administering justice as well as on all public officials. Liturgically, the Red Mass gets its name from the red color of vestments worn by the clergy symbolizing the tongues of fire and is celebrated as the Solemn Mass of the Holy Spirit.
