HOW TO FORM A DEEPER RELATIONSHIP

If you find yourself asking, "Is this all there is?" your relationship may be missing a deeper sense of shared meaning. In his work, Dr. John Gottman identified four pillars of shared meaning:

- 1. Rituals of connection: A ritual is a structured event or routine that you each enjoy that reinforces your sense of togetherness. They can be big or small, created around special days such as anniversaries or birthdays, or everyday interactions such as how you start your mornings or spend your weekends.
- **2. Support for each other's roles:** your roles and your partner's can either add to the meaningfulness and harmony between you or create tension. If your expectations of yourself and each other are similar (for example, having similar views on parenting, work, and other major life values), you'll experience more meaning and connection.
- **3. Shared goals:** part of what makes life meaningful are the goals we strive to achieve. Not only will you increase the closeness in your relationship by sharing your deepest objectives with your partner, but working towards goals together can make your union even richer.
- **4. Shared values and symbols:** values and beliefs are what you use to guide your lives. For some people, values are deeply rooted in faith or religious conviction. For others, values are represented by symbols of love and meaning. They can be objects or intangible. For example, the home can be symbolic of love and life together. Family stories are richly symbolic, as are precious items or photos.

The goal shouldn't be to agree on every aspect of what is profoundly meaningful to you, but to have a relationship where you are both open to each other's most dearly held beliefs.
