FUNDING THE MINISTRY OF THE DIOCESE OF HELENA

Did you know that 17% of the Annual Catholic Appeal funds are utilized for Parish Support?

One component of Parish Support is Human Resource Services. Employees of the Diocese provide direction and resources for employees working in the parishes, institutions and offices of the Diocese of Helena. Individual parishes often cannot afford to hire their own Human Resources person, and the individuals serving in this capacity at the Diocese help with job descriptions, understanding benefits such as health insurance, the hiring process, training, performance reviews and the promotion of wellness.

Another component of Parish Support is the Catholic Communications Campaign. This is a national campaign that helps the Church spread the Gospel message through media. Half of all of the donations to the Catholic Communications Campaign stay in our diocese to support local communication needs such as television programing, radio and publications.
