FUNDING THE MINISTRY OF THE DIOCESE OF HELENA

As we enter the seventh weekend of the Annual Catholic Appeal, we wanted to share with you the progress that St. Anthony Parish has made toward its goal! The Diocese is reporting that St. Anthony's generous parishioners have pledged \$1,220 and contributed \$10,150, for a total of \$11,370 toward our goal of \$51,300. These contributions get us to 22% of our goal with 18% of our parishioners participating! If you have not yet made your pledge, we encourage you to do so today. You have the option of paying now or spreading your contribution out over the next several months.

A portion of the Annual Catholic Appeal helps to fund Catholic Social Services of Montana. Catholic Social Services provides confidential counseling throughout our state for expectant parents who need assistance to become new parents to their baby. Additional services include adoption placement, post-adoption support, Rachael's Hope (post-abortion help), youth mentoring and supportive aid to birth mothers. In 2023, CCSM began planning for a launch of a mental health services program to improve access to counseling, therapy and education statewide. Let us share what we have in gratitude for the gifts of life and family.
