FUNDING THE MINISTRY OF THE DIOCESE OF HELENA

The Diocese of Helena encompasses 57 Parishes and 38 Missions, served by 61 Priests. The important work of the Chancery, which includes the offices and ministries of the Diocese of Helena, is funded in part by the Annual Catholic Appeal. The ACA funds will be used over a 12-month period to support the work of our parishes and, wherever possible, expand the mission of the Church.

The total goal for the ACA is \$2,000,000. Of that amount, 14% is budgeted for Relief and Hope ministries, which include prison ministry, Catholic cemeteries, Catholic Social Services of Montana, the Guatemala Mission, the Montana Catholic Conference, and three national collections for the Archdiocese for Military Services, the Church in Central and Eastern Europe and the Church in Africa. 
#### **MASS INTENTIONS**
