CONVENIENT GIVING OPTION

St. Anthony parish has begun working with Give Central, which is the online giving platform that the Diocese of Helena uses. The online giving platform will give you the opportunity to make a contribution to the parish from a bank account or with a credit or debit card in a one-time gift or as a recurring gift. The platform will give you the opportunity to setup an account or give as a guest, but we encourage you to setup an account if you use the platform so that you have access to your giving history or to modify recurring gifts.

With Give Central, you can create an account and see what you have contributed and make modifications on your own instead of having to go through the parish office. If you are on Direct Deposit, you are not impacted unless you choose to make a change.
