ASH WEDNESDAY: FEBRUARY 14

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten season. **Catholics 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and every Friday of Lent.**

If you are between the ages of 18-59, you are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. That means eating one full meal and two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength. Together, the smaller meals should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not encouraged, but liquids are allowed.



Even though Valentine's Day falls on Ash Wednesday this year, no dispensations to fasting or abstaining from meat have been granted by the Diocese. It's a wonderful opportunity to eat your favorite healthy fish or vegetarian meal!
