FAMILY PROMISE UPDATE

Family Promise is a volunteer organization that helps our Missoula homeless families. We provide them with food and assistance at the Meadowlark Family Housing Center on 3rd Street.

2023 Census Numbers

- 107 families entered the Family Housing Center shelter last year.
- That includes 164 adults and 179 children (80 children under 5 years old) to total 343 people.
- 52% exited into a positive housing destination.
- The average length of stay was 96 days.

FRIDAY FISH FRY



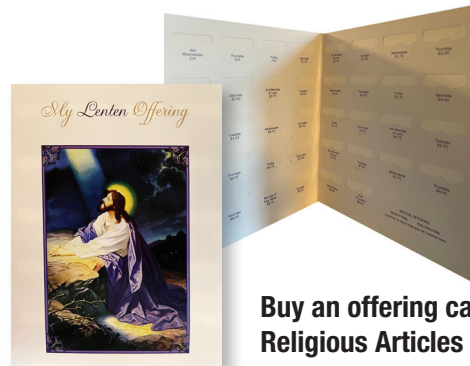

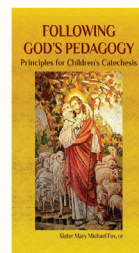
