
ASH WEDNESDAY: FEBRUARY 14

A week from this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten season. Catholics 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and every Friday of Lent.

If you are between the ages of 18-59, you are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. That means eating one full meal and two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength. Together, the smaller meals should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not encouraged, but liquids are allowed.

- Ash Wednesday, February 14: 12:10pm Mass in the Church
- Fridays during Lent:
 5:10pm Stations of the Cross followed by Mass in the Church and then the Knights Fish Fry in the PLC
- The Rite of Election for our Catechumens: Sunday, February 18 in Helena. (Please pray for our 2 Catechumens and their Sponsors.)
- Holy Thursday, March 28: 7pm Mass in the Church followed by Adoration
- Good Friday Service and Veneration of the Cross: 12:10pm in the Church
- Holy Saturday Easter Mass, March 30: 9pm (No 5pm Mass that day)
- Easter Sunday Masses, March 31: 8:30am and 11:10am


