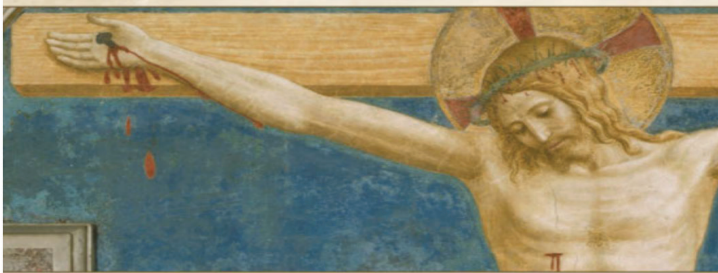
C.E.E.K. MEETING MARCH 24
