FAST & ABSTAIN ON GOOD FRIDAY

Catholics 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on Good Friday.

If you are between the ages of 18-59, you are required to fast on Good Friday. That means eating one full meal and two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength. Together, the smaller meals should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not encouraged, but liquids are allowed.

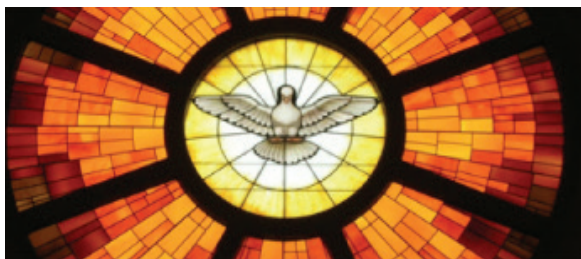
