For All Parishioners Who Bring Holy Communion to the Sick and Homebound

Thank you so much for your valuable ministry. We want to inform you that the Eucharist should always be consumed when received at Mass. For those bringing Communion to the sick or homebound, it must be carried in a small container called a pyx and immediately brought to them. The Holy Eucharist should not be kept in the pocket and/or car for the next day.

If you are unable to come forward at Mass to receive Communion, please sit in the front row so the Eucharist can be brought to you.


