As summer approaches, many of you spend time away from Missoula on vacations and weekend trips. Even though you're away, our expenses are still here. Please consider online giving or Direct Deposit to help us carry on while you're gone so we can function normally until you return.

CONVENIENT GIVING OPTION

St. Anthony parish is working with Give Central, which is the online giving platform that the Diocese of Helena uses. The online giving platform will give you the opportunity to make a contribution to the parish from a bank account or with a credit or debit card in a one-time gift or as a recurring gift. The platform will give you the opportunity to setup an account or give as a guest, but we encourage you to setup an account if you use the platform so that you have access to your giving history or to modify recurring gifts.

With Give Central, you can create an account and see what you have contributed and make modifications on your own instead of having to go through the parish office. If you are on Direct Deposit, you are not impacted unless you choose to make a change.

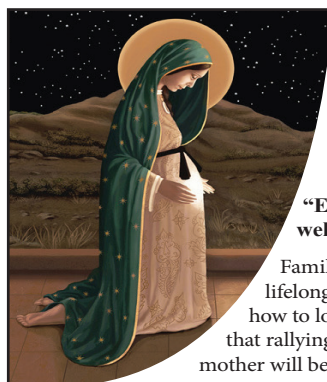
EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Montana Catholics For Life

For Babies For Mothers For Families

"Every child that arrives is God's gift. Every baby, in every case, and in whatever situation is to be welcomed." —Pope Francis via video *Love Brightens the World's Darkness*, 2021

Families are sacred. They are the domestic church and the most significant factor in helping determine the lifelong flourishing of each member, children and parents alike. Part of the reason for this is that they know how to lovingly meet challenges together, including the challenge of an unplanned pregnancy. They understand that rallying to support a new mother is a true expression of love and that her life as a mother will be deeply fulfilling and enriching.

Motherhood, even if unplanned, is a gift to women, their children, families, and all of society. It is not a prescription for certain failure or poverty, and it is certainly not a "problem" that needs to be solved by taking the life of a child through abortion. Families know this and throughout history have supported mothers with unplanned pregnancies.

CI-128 would enshrine abortion in the State Constitution of Montana eliminating regulations by rendering them unconstitutional. This includes the current requirement for parental notification when a minor obtains an abortion. This change is unacceptable as it eliminates a young mother's very best chance of flourishing in life by creating a barrier of secrecy between her and her family. Mothers deserve better in Montana.
