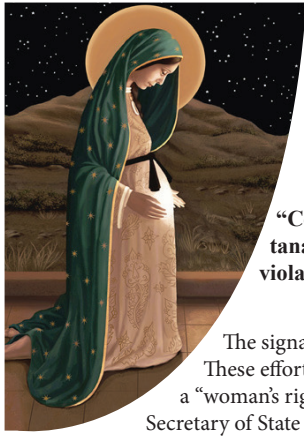

“Constitutional Initiative 128 (CI-128) would greatly expand the practice of legalized abortion in Montana abolishing the limited restrictions currently in place and opening the door to a host of practices that violate fundamental rights to life and dignity.”

The signature gathering efforts to place Constitutional Initiative 128 (CI-128) on the November ballot have concluded. These efforts included substantial out-of-state funding, signing events, and vague messaging that often framed CI-128 as a “woman’s right to make her own healthcare decisions.” In the coming weeks, amidst likely legal challenges, the Montana Secretary of State will confirm whether the signature gathering was successful or not.

During the signature verification and count, our Catholic bishops will continue messaging the great threat that CI-128 poses to unborn children, expectant mothers, and families. Regardless of the outcome, the Church will fulfill her duty to boldly speak out and stand up for the infinite dignity of life from conception until a natural death.

Let us remain prayerfully vigilant, continuing with the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be after each Mass. Let our prayer intention be for the defeat of CI-128 but even more so for a change of heart. We pray for a transformation in our hearts and the hearts of all people, especially expectant mothers and those who would promote abortion over loving each new life as a precious and unrepeatable gift.

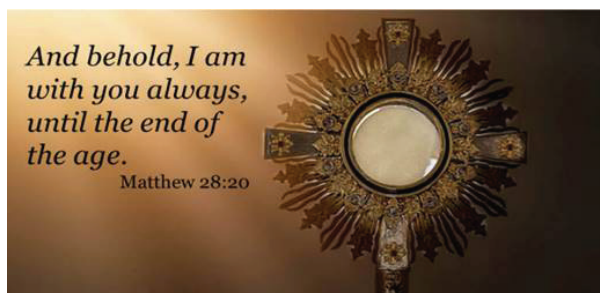

CONVENIENT GIVING OPTION

St. Anthony parish is working with Give Central, which is the online giving platform that the Diocese of Helena uses. The online giving platform will give you the opportunity to make a contribution to the parish from a bank account or with a credit or debit card in a one-time gift or as a recurring gift. The platform will give you the opportunity to setup an account or give as a guest, but we encourage you to setup an account if you use the platform so that you have access to your giving history or to modify recurring gifts.

With Give Central, you can create an account and see what you have contributed and make modifications on your own instead of having to go through the parish office. If you are on Direct Deposit, you are not impacted unless you choose to make a change.
