## SPECIAL POVERELLO SUMMER REQUEST

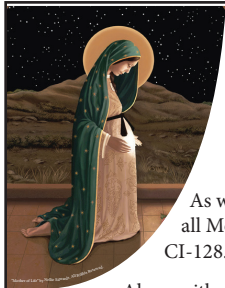
