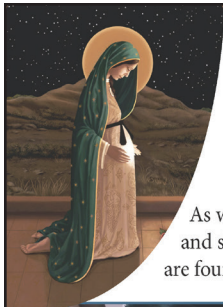

## MASS INTENTIONS OR ALTAR BREAD & WINE DONATIONS

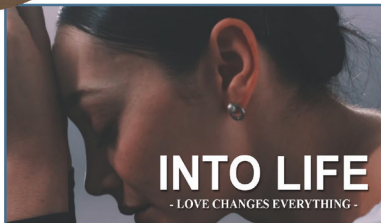

### Into Life Series: *Vulnerability: An Identity Crisis*

In this powerful video, the Sisters of Life talk about the realities that can lead a woman who is unexpectedly pregnant to choose abortion, which stems from an experience of profound vulnerability. When we strive to listen and accompany women in a time of fear and doubt, we can better understand the pressures and temptation she faces in this moment of crisis. Through presence and love, we can create space to reflect and find faith in herself and in her capacity for motherhood. *"This is precisely at the heart of what it means to be pro-life: to see the goodness, the beauty, the capacity of each of the women who come to us. To reflect back to her [the] truth of her identity, so that she can make an act of faith in herself and incorporate motherhood into her self-identity."*



### Faithful Citizenship Series: *Prudence*

In this video, MCC Executive Director Matt Brower shines a light on the virtue of prudence, which allows us to discern "the good", and the best way of achieving it. He discusses cultivating prudence through humble effort, understanding the principles given to us by the Church to aid us. He explains how we can then begin to examine the intrinsic evils and the goods brought forward by political candidates and expressed in legislation to sharpen our discernment when it comes time to vote.
