TODAY'S READING: WORSHIP BOOK #1006



This Monday, December 9, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and Mass will be celebrated in the church at 12:10 pm.



Did you know that each month has a traditional Catholic devotion? The devotion for December is the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is celebrated nine months before the birth of Mary.

The Blessed Virgin Mary was preserved from all stain of original sin. This was defined by Pope Pius IX in 1854 as an article of revealed truth. She was not freed from original sin after contracting it, instead, she never contracted it.

During December when we observe Advent and a month devoted to Mary, take time to reflect on her purity and the true meaning of the birth of her son. In a season of extravagance with Christmas shopping and parties, just saying a simple prayer each day: "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee," keeps her in our hearts and focus. It's truly a simple way to invoke someone so divine.
