
### THANKS, LINDA! WELCOME, REBECCA!

Located on the second floor of the Parish Life Center, the library is well-stocked with a wide array of resources suitable for children, parents, and seniors, along with an extensive selection of theological works.

Our children's section is extensive, featuring resources for parents, books that educate children about living a Catholic life, as well as topics on the Saints, Bible stories, sacraments, death, divorce, bullying, and teenage issues.
