

We invite you to relax and enjoy our library's cozy atmosphere with a cup of coffee in hand! Located on the second floor of the Parish Life Center, the library is well-stocked with a wide array of resources suitable for children, parents, and seniors, along with an extensive selection of theological works. We also have a St. Anthony Parish history section that has materials about our parish throughout its 100 + year history.

Our children's section is extensive, featuring resources for parents, books that educate children about living a Catholic life, as well as topics on the Saints, Bible stories, sacraments, death, divorce, bullying, mental health and teenage issues. Feel free to bring your children with you — the library provides games to keep them engaged while you enjoy your reading. It's also equipped with children's toys, coloring books, and even a tipi for reading.

Our borrowing system is simple: take a book and return it at your convenience—there is no formal checkout process.

We take great pride in our library and extend our gratitude to everyone who has contributed books over the years and continue to do so. The library is open daily from 10am to 3pm, Monday through Thursday, with extended hours on Wednesdays from 5:30pm to 7:30pm.
