SUNDAY'S READING: WORSHIP BOOK #1120

THE PRESENTATION

This Sunday, the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time is a period that represents the ministry of Jesus following His baptism at the age of thirty. However, this week we pause to commemorate the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, which occurred forty days after His birth.

Mary and Joseph, like many generations of Jewish parents, were required to present their new son to God following the dictates of the Mosaic Law. According to this custom, the first-born son was to be consecrated to the Lord (Exodus 13:2) and the mother to be purified in the temple. Additionally, an offering of two turtle doves or two young pigeons, along with a lamb, was required. Given that Mary and Joseph were a modest family, the lamb they offered was, symbolically, the Lamb of God—signifying Jesus' inaugural appearance in the Temple.

In Jewish tradition during the presentation, the mother participated in a ritual of purification. The priest also purified himself by bathing before entering the holy place. This practice is echoed in the liturgy of the Mass, where the priest washes his hands prior to the Eucharistic Prayer and the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ.

CANDLEMAS

Baby Jesus was presented to God in the temple and presented back to the world. Jesus is the Holy One whose heavenly light shines even amid the world's darkness, as Candlemas celebrates.

Candlemas originated as a Christian festival in Jerusalem around 350 AD. It commemorates the presentation of Jesus at the Temple of Jerusalem and is celebrated 40 days after Christmas on February 2. The name Candlemas comes from the custom of blessing and distributing candles in procession before Mass. To honor this tradition, you can bring your home candles and Father Pascal will bless them after Mass.
