SACRED PLACES FOR THE JUBILEE INDULGENCE

To the Faithful of the Diocese of Helena:

Greetings to you this Jubilee Year of Hope! Last May, our Holy Father Pope Francis released the Bull of Induction *Spes non confundit* ("Hope does not disappoint") announcing this Jubilee Year 2025. A Jubilee Year is a significant time in the life of the Church marked by pilgrimages, processions, and a special invitation to the Sacrament of Penance. In it, we are called to receive God's mercy by participating in the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy and, in a special way, through the practice of the Jubilee Indulgence. In response to this, and in accordance with the directives of the Holy See, I, Austin Anthony Vetter, Bishop of Helena, hereby designate the following sacred places within the diocese of Helena as places where the faithful may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence:

- Cathedral of St. Helena, Helena
- St. Theresa of the Little Flower Church, Browning
- St. Joseph Church, Libby
- St. Ignatius Mission Church. St. Ignatius
- St. Rose of Lima Church, Dillion
- Holy Rosary Church, Bozeman
- All Saints Chapel, Carroll College, Helena

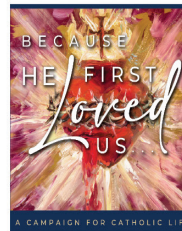

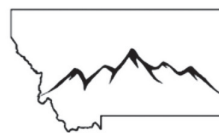
