On behalf of the families at the Meadowlark, they are most thankful for your continued support of the Family Promise program. It truly makes a difference!

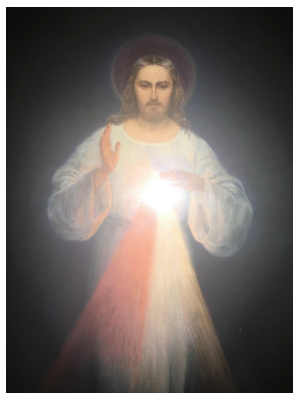

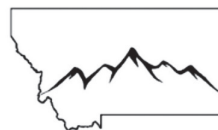
