## CANONIZATION OF 1ST MILLENNIAL SAINT



Canonization of Blessed St. Carlo Acutis will be on Sunday, April 27. Carlo Acutis was born on May 3, 1991 in London, England, and died from leukemia in Monza, Italy on Oct. 12, 2006. A miracle attributed to his intercession

was approved by Pope Francis on Feb. 22, 2020. He was beatified on Oct. 10, 2020. A second miracle was confirmed in May 2024. He was known for his devotion to the Eucharist and his use of technology to spread faith, particularly his website documenting Eucharistic miracles.

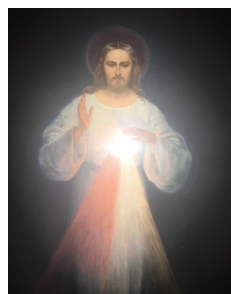

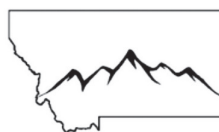
