CANONIZATION OF 1ST MILLENNIAL SAINT



Canonization of Blessed St. Carlo Acutis will be on Sunday, April 27. Carlo was born on May 3, 1991 in London and died from leukemia in Monza, Italy on Oct. 12, 2006. A miracle attributed his intercession to was approved by Pope Francis on Feb. 22, 2020. He was beatified

on Oct. 10, 2020. A second miracle was confirmed in May 2024. He was known for his devotion to the Eucharist and his use of technology to spread faith, particularly his website documenting Eucharistic miracles.

Divine Mercy Sunday Celebration at St. Anthony's April 27, 2025 2 pm

Here are suggestions on how to prepare for this celebration (all resources can be found online):

- **Reflect on God's mercy** through daily prayer or Scripture (e.g., Psalm 51, John 20:19-31).
- **Read St. Faustina's Diary** for insights into the Divine Mercy message.
- **Pray the nine-day novena,** beginning on Good Friday, using the Divine Mercy Chaplet. (*Readily found online, you can catch up by praying the missed days, if you didn't begin on Good Friday.*)
- **Go to Confession** to receive a plenary indulgence (full remission of temporal punishment for sins).
- Aim for a thorough, heartfelt confession, ideally within 20 days before or after the feast.
- Attend Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday, as receiving Communion in a state of grace is key to the indulgence.
- Perform corporal or spiritual works of mercy (e.g., feeding the hungry, praying for the deceased) during the week.
- Show kindness and forgiveness to others, reflecting Jesus' mercy.
- Venerate the Divine Mercy image. We have one in our church and will venerate the image during our celebration.
- Understand the plenary indulgence conditions: Confession, Communion, prayer for the Pope's intentions, and detachment from sin.
- **Participate in Divine Mercy devotions** at a church or chapel for the indulgence.
- Foster trust in Jesus' mercy through small daily surrenders.
- **Share the Divine Mercy devotion** with family or friends, perhaps invite them to pray the Chaplet.
