The nun asked if he had money in the bank. He shook his head and replied, "I don't."

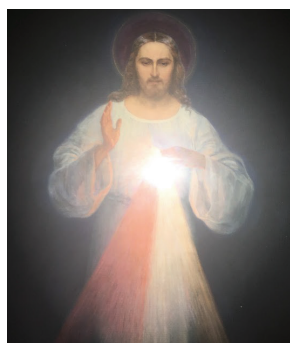
The nun asked, "Do you have a relative who could help you?"

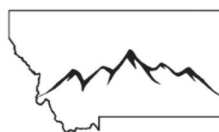
