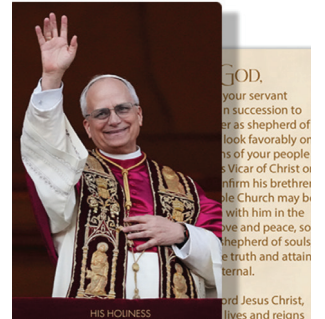
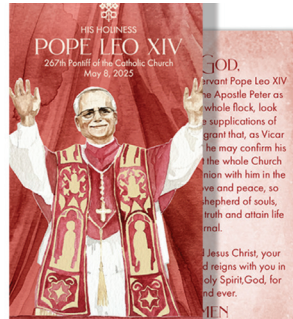

It was a Marian year in 1954, on May 30, when Father was ordained in Zaragoza, Spain after fleeing his homeland during the high days of Mao Zedong's reign of terror.

Such an enduring blessing has Fr. Wang been to our parish, the Missoula area and the entire diocese for nearly 60 years!

There is no finer way to honor him than to pray for the Chinese evangelization work which he and Beckie spearhead on this side of the Pacific in collaboration with the team on Chinese soil. At this year's Easter Vigil, 92 families comprised of 295 people were baptized! Work is now underway to prepare for more baptisms on the Solemnity of the Assumption.

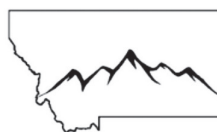
