**JULY HONORS THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST**

**The Significance of the Precious Blood of Christ**

Just as our bodies need blood to survive, the church flourishes through the Precious Blood of Christ. The Bible mentions blood over 400 times, emphasizing that without the shedding of Christ's most precious blood, our faith and salvation would lack true significance.

**A Historical Perspective**

Although recognizing the importance of Christ's most precious blood dates back thousands of years, did you know that a special feast day was established in its honor due to a promise made by Pope Pius IX?

During the First Italian War for Independence in 1849, Pope Pius IX found himself in exile with one of the missionary Fathers of the Most Precious Blood. Seeking a way to end the conflict, his friend suggested creating a feast to honor the Precious Blood. Pope Pius embraced this idea, and shortly thereafter, the conflict came to an end.


