

33-Day Consecration to St. Joseph for Missoula Catholic Fathers and their Sons

Wed., September 3 – Sat., October 4

St. Anthony parish is hosting a 33 Day Consecration to St. Joseph for fathers (stepfathers/uncles or grandpas) and their sons.

It will take place in the Parish Life Center located at 217 Tremont St and is open to all parishes. There will be six Wednesday night meetings, September 3, 10, 17, 24 and October 1 and 4, from 6-8 pm, 45 minutes of discussion and about an hour for dinner.

The 33-day Consecration to St. Joseph is a powerful tool our Church has given us to strengthen our faith and gives credence to Catholic manhood. Please bring the young men in your family, ages 10+. St. Anthony will provide all the reading materials and daily prayers for you to follow for 33 days with your sons. Facilitator, Andy McManus will be using Father Donald Calloway's, Consecration to St. Joseph: The Wonders of Our Spiritual Father.

The 33-day Consecration requires about 10 minutes daily of scripture reading, a little theology, prayer and promotes conversations about spiritual maturity and Catholic manhood with your son.
