PARKING LOT UPDATE

We have been diligently working on a plan to improve the parking lot and wanted to share an update with you. We put in a permit application with the City of Missoula in May 2025 for a full replacement of the asphalt. Several experts examined the parking lot and determined that the asphalt had failed. Accordingly a plan was developed to remove the existing asphalt, grade the underlying surface, add drainage and lay new asphalt.

A full replacement of asphalt triggers other City requirements that we have spent a great deal of time working through. Those requirements include curbing and landscaping. Currently we believe we have submitted all of the information the City has requested in a format that we believe meets their requirements and are waiting to hear back. The Parish has received donations specific to the parking lot. In addition, we designated a portion of our Capital Campaign Capital Improvement funds for this purpose. Based upon the budget proposed by our contractor, the funds reserved should fully cover the cost. We appreciate your patience and any prayers you are willing to offer.
