## PARKING LOT UPDATE

We have been working on a plan to improve the parking lot and want to share an update with you. Several experts examined the parking lot and determined that the asphalt had failed. We put in a permit application with the City of Missoula in May 2025 for a full replacement of the asphalt. Accordingly a plan was developed to remove the existing asphalt, grade the underlying surface, add drainage and lay new asphalt.

Full asphalt replacement triggers other requirements including curbing and landscaping that we have spent a great deal of time working through. We believe we have submitted all of the information the City has requested in a format that meets their requirements and are waiting to hear back. The Parish has received donations specific to the parking lot. In addition, we designated a portion of our Capital Campaign Capital Improvement funds for this purpose. Based upon the budget proposed by our contractor, the funds reserved should fully cover the cost. We appreciate your patience and any prayers you are willing to offer.

## 33-DAY CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

for Missoula Catholic Fathers and their Sons

**Continuing Thurs. Sept. 4 – Sat. Oct. 4**

St. Anthony parish has been hosting a 33 Day Consecration to St. Joseph for fathers (stepfathers/uncles or grandpas) and their sons ages 10+. It takes place in the Parish Life Center and is open to all parishes. There is one Thursday night meeting remaining on October 2 and one on Saturday, October 4, from 6-8 pm, **45 minutes of discussion and about an hour for a free dinner.**

This is a powerful tool to strengthen your faith and promote conversations about spiritual maturity and Catholic manhood with your son.
