Daylight Savings Time ends this Sunday, November 2. If you didn't set your clocks back, you may be an hour early for Mass!

NOVEMBER 1: ALL SAINTS' DAY

Since All Saints' Day this year falls on Saturday, November 1, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. The obligation to attend Mass is lifted when these three feasts: Solemnity of Mary (January 1), the Assumption (August 15) or All Saints (November 1) fall on a Saturday or Monday, according to a decree approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.
