### ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

**Vocation Awareness Promotion** – Helping priests promote and share the beauty of religious and priestly vocations to those who are discerning the call of Christ in their lives.

**Bishop's Office and Pastoral Outreach** – The Bishop's Office and Pastoral Outreach consists of his ongoing deanery visits, as well as visits to the college campuses in the diocese.

**Delegate for Religious** – The delegate for religious cares for the ordinary needs of religious who serve the people of our diocese.

**Tribunal** – The Tribunal of the Diocese of Helena assists with the pastoral care of divorced and remarried persons seeking to have their marriage recognized in the church, divorced persons seeking to remarry, and divorced persons seeking clarification of their standing in the Church.

**Vatican Apostolic Ministries** – Contributes to pastoral ministries and initiatives of the Holy Father, Pope Leo.


