AREAS THAT ACA FUNDING SUPPORTS

Catholic Education and Faith Formation

Journey – A three-day retreat available to anyone. People come together and have the amazing opportunity to experience Catholic spirituality from the lives of other Catholic laypeople. Local priests, deacons and religious assist as spiritual directors, and attendees grow through reflecting on the Faith, personal testimonies, and prayer.

Lay Ministry Formation – Well-formed ministers that actively participate are crucial in the life of the Church. While providing professional support to our priests and religious, they offer an example of Christ to others while leading a life of discipleship.

Legendary Lodge, Salmon Lake – A weeklong experience of joy, discovery, and Catholic community for youth. Excellent counselors serve as role models and guides in an encounter with Christ through prayer, sacrament and fun-filled days.

Youth, Young Adult and Adult Catholic Formation – Encompasses the training and resources for the development of a comprehensive vision of youth and young adult ministry in parish, school, and communities.

Historical Preservation – The Diocese of Helena Archives curates the records and artifacts of the Diocese from its start in 1884 to the present. It operates in accordance with church law and collaborate with local civil and private organizations. Parish Baptismal and Marriage records through the year 2000 are digitized, with further records retention underway.

Liturgical Training – Provides education and ongoing training to those who will participate as ministers at Mass.

Campus Ministry – Provides funding for Campus Ministry at Carroll College, MSU, UM, Montana Technological University, and University of Montana Western.

Catholic Schools – Supports the development of and collaboration with: Butte Central H.S., Loyola Sacred Heart H.S., St. Andrew Schl, Butte Central Elem., St. Andrew, St. Joseph Catholic Schl, and St. Matthew Elem.

De La Salle Blackfeet School – Operated by the De La Salle Christian Brothers, DLSB School is for boys and girls living on the Blackfeet Indian Reservation. DLSB works to create an environment that recognizes the reality of God's living presence, and nurtures the dignity of each student within a supportive community of teachers, parents, and guardians.

Catholic University, Washington D.C. – A component of National Catholic Collections, it was founded by American Bishops over 130 years ago to be the university of the Catholic Church in the U.S. and it has produced graduates that embrace both reason and faith as they apply the resources of the Catholic intellectual tradition to help solve the problems of contemporary life.
