SUNDAY'S READING: WORSHIP BOOK #1118

February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Although this year it is not a day of obligation, it is worthy to ponder the meaning of this ritual. This feast always occurs 40 days after Christmas. Also called The Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, it is also known as Candlemas.

This custom is rooted in the Old Testament Book of Exodus (Chapter 13). It required the consecration of all first born males to the Lord, because the Lord spared the life of the Israelites' first born sons when he sent the first plague upon the Egyptians — the plague that forced the pharaoh to allow the Israelites to leave Egypt and become a free people. So the original idea was to consecrate the first born son to serve the Lord.
