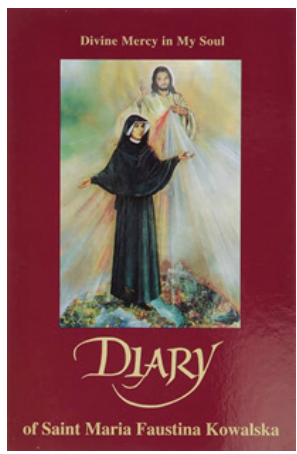

MASS INTENTIONS

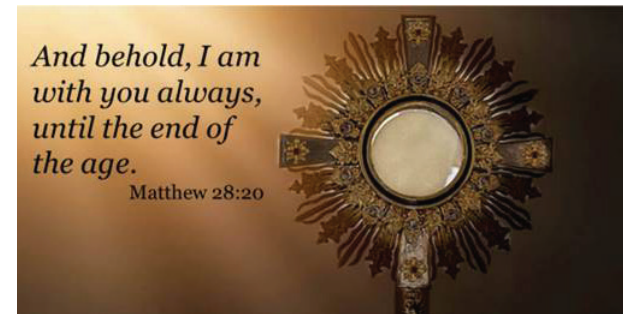
