Divine Mercy Sunday Celebration
at St. Anthony Church, April 12, 2:00pm

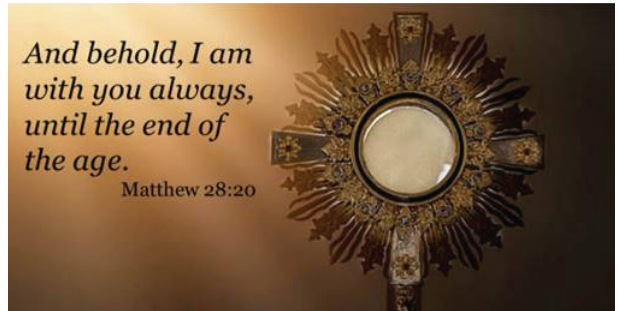
