Dear St. Anthony parishioners,

Today we rejoice and are glad to celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, the great mystery of our redemption. The Easter celebration is the foundation of Christianity because if Christ did not rise from the dead, vain and futile would have been our faith. The resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ celebrates the victory of life over death, the victory of love over hatred. We come to this celebration with joy but also with sentiments of uncertainties, fears about the tragedy we are observing in today's world.
