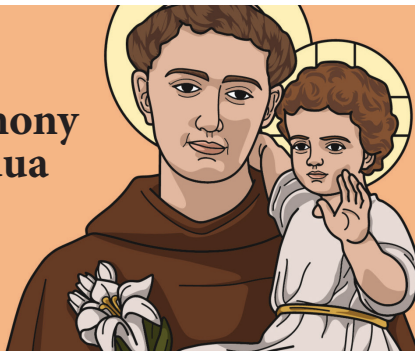

Happy Feast of St. Anthony!

SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA: FEAST DAY JUNE 13

Anthony was born (1195 AD) in Lisbon, Portugal, but his desire to meet Saint Francis of Assisi and join his order brought him to Italy.

Once a Franciscan, Anthony went about serving the poor and sick. He cared first for their physical needs. Then he would remind them that Jesus too had no possessions and he began to preach the Gospel. Anthony is an official Doctor of the church because his intellectual insights have greatly informed the church understanding of Theology.

So many people wonder “**why is he the patron saint of lost things?**” The story is that he had a book of Psalms that he absolutely loved. One day, a monk stole it and left the Franciscan community. Anthony prayed with all his might for the return and soon the monk was struck by intense guilt and brought the book back. Soon after Saint Anthony’s death, people began praying to him whenever they deeply desired the return of a lost item. And this devotion broadened over the centuries.

But the greater lesson of Saint Anthony’s life is that he helped lost people find Jesus. And that is what we are called to do as well, even if it is helping ourselves find Jesus after we have lost Him.

We lose Jesus in our lives all the time. We wander away from Jesus all the time. We are either not aware of it, or we do it on purpose. Our task is to find Jesus again and again. He is always waiting for us to return. All we have to do is say, “Jesus, here I am, and I need you.” We can talk to a priest or call upon a trusted friend who is firm in their faith. And if we need that extra help, we can turn to Saint Anthony of Padua.

Where in my life have I lost Jesus and how can I find Him again? Who else in my life can I help find Jesus?

Saint Anthony of Padua, pray for us.

FORMER PARISHIONER NEWS



Dorothy Dolores Kinsley (nee Dunbar) departed peacefully in the early morning hours of October 7, 2025. She was born on February 27, 1937, in Butte, Montana.

While a student at the University of Montana, Dorothy met Glenn H. Kinsley, and they were married on August 16, 1959. They were blessed with two daughters: Nancy (Willy) Self and Rebecca (Gerard) Poteat.

Dorothy's career in education began with teaching elementary school in California and Missoula. In 1965, she joined Head Start, initially as a teacher and later as an education director. She worked with Head Start teachers across Montana, supporting them in obtaining certification to teach early education. Later she was the assistant director of Financial Aid at the University of Montana, where she worked for 12 years. After retiring, Dorothy remained active in the community, contributing to several nonprofit organizations in Missoula. Her favorite post-retirement position was at St. Anthony's Catholic Church.

Her funeral Mass will be held at St. Anthony's on Thursday, June 25 at 11 am with a reception to follow at noon in the Parish Life Center.
