**WANTED: SOCKS AND UNDERWEAR**

The Gary Turbak Memorial Back to School Clothing Project has been held at St. Paul Lutheran Church since 1987. Social agencies in Missoula are contacted for the names of needy families in the valley who have children ages 4-13. The families are invited to the church basement to the "store" where new clothes are arranged by size and gender. Last year about 500 children got a pair of jeans, a top, a whole package of socks & underwear and a pair of shoes—all new! St. Anthony's is among other local churches that are collecting packages of new kids' underwear and socks. A box will be at the back of church for your donations.

## JUNE IS DEDICATED TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Devotion to the Sacred Heart is relatively recent in Catholic spirituality. It gained impetus in seventeenth century through a French nun, Margaret Mary Alacoque. Starting in 1673, Margaret Mary experienced a series of visions of the Sacred Heart, which she recorded and entrusted to her confessor, the Jesuit St. Claude de la Colombière. He believed her and saw that the spiritual fruits of what she said were growing.

Some of the key elements of Margaret Mary's visions were: (1) the idea of a Holy Hour on Thursdays (an hour of adoration before the exposed Blessed Sacrament, in imitation of the apostles waiting with Jesus in Gethsemane) (2) the practice of encouraging reception of Communion on the first Friday of the month (in honor of the Sacred Heart and Jesus' Passion), and (3) the institution of a Feast of the Sacred Heart on the Friday after Corpus Christi.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart was initially limited to Margaret Mary's own Visitandine Order but gradually spread in France. The Church soberly took her time to observe the fruits of the devotion, and in 1856, Pope Pius IX instituted it as a feast for the whole Church.

Included in Margaret Mary's visions were these "Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus" she received from Christ (hence the "I" statements). They are:

- (1) I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- (2) I will give peace in their families.
- (3) I will console them in all their troubles.
- (4) I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- (5) I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- (6) Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- (7) Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- (8) Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- (9) I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- (10) I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- (11) Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- (12) In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the first Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: They will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

## FUNERAL MASS THIS THURSDAY



Dorothy Dolores Kinsley (nee Dunbar) departed peacefully in the early morning hours of October 7, 2025. She was born on February 27, 1937, in Butte, Montana.

While a student at the University of Montana, Dorothy met Glenn H. Kinsley, and they were married on August 16, 1959. They were blessed with two daughters: Nancy (Willy) Self and Rebecca (Gerard) Poteat.

Dorothy's career in education began with teaching elementary school in California and Missoula. In 1965, she joined Head Start, initially as a teacher and later as an education director. She worked with Head Start teachers across Montana, supporting them in obtaining certification to teach early education. Later she was the assistant director of Financial Aid at the University of Montana, where she worked for 12 years. After retiring, Dorothy remained active in the community, contributing to several nonprofit organizations in Missoula. Her favorite post-retirement position was at St. Anthony's Catholic Church.

**Her funeral Mass will be held at St. Anthony's on Thursday, June 25 at 11 am with a reception to follow at noon in the Parish Life Center.**
