SUNDAY'S READING: WORSHIP BOOK #1145



The Eucharist is the Visible Reality of Jesus Love

In 1675, Christ appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), a French nun. Holding His heart engulfed in flames, Christ proclaimed, "Behold my heart which so loved men." He asked that devotion to his Sacred Heart be spread, particularly by celebrating it with a special feast.

That is why devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Eucharistic devotion are inseparable. At the Last Supper, Christ reveals that the Eucharist stems from His heart. The Eucharist is the visible reality of Jesus' love. It is the way through which Christ fulfills His promise to stay with us. That is why the church calls the Eucharist the Sacrament of Charity, as it springs from God's heart.

The question we may ponder in our minds and hearts is – how to love Christ's heart and return His love with our love. Here are some spiritual and practical ways:

1. Lovingly prepare to receive the Eucharist by arriving early for Mass.
2. When receiving communion, you should be aware of Christ's loving presence and ask the grace to imitate His love.
3. Spend time meditating upon Christ's Sacred Heart.
4. Go to Eucharistic Adoration and/or Holy Hour.
5. Whenever you see a Catholic church, stop and visit the Eucharistic Jesus.

May the heart of Jesus in the most Holy Sacrament be praised and adored.
